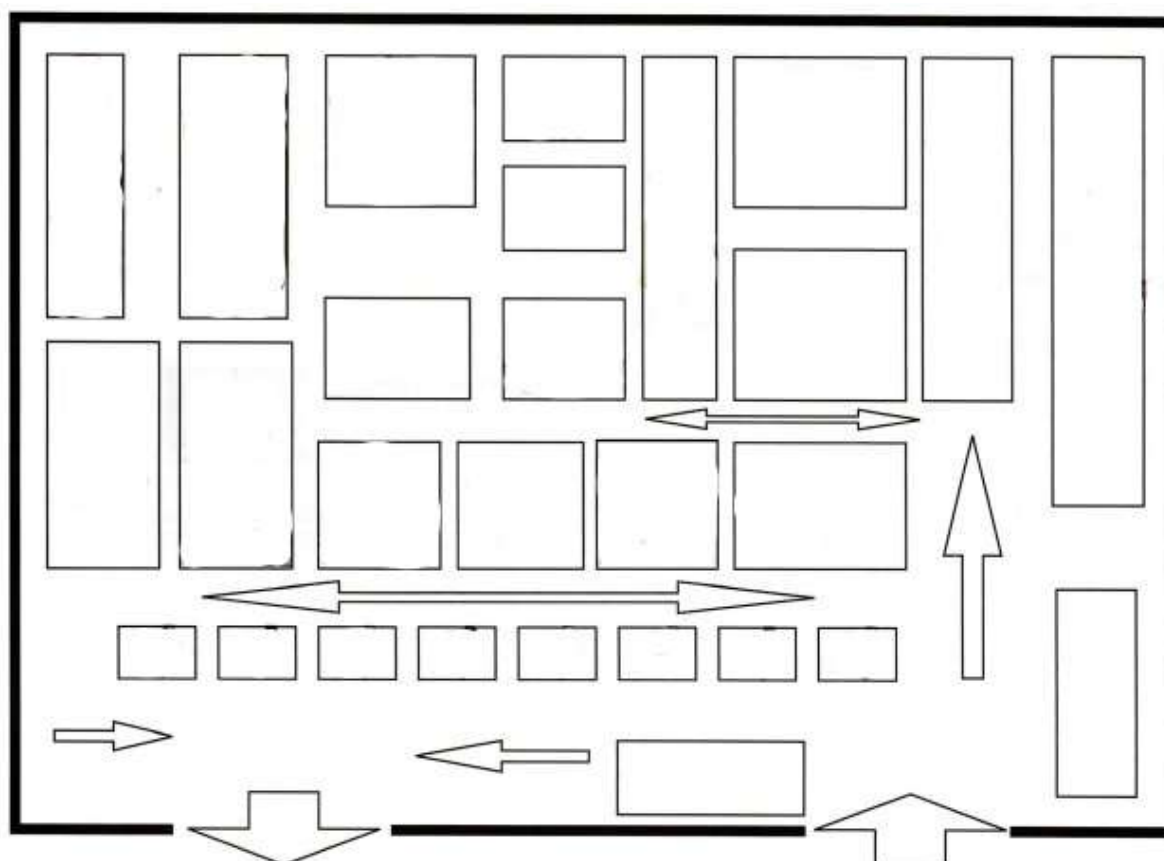
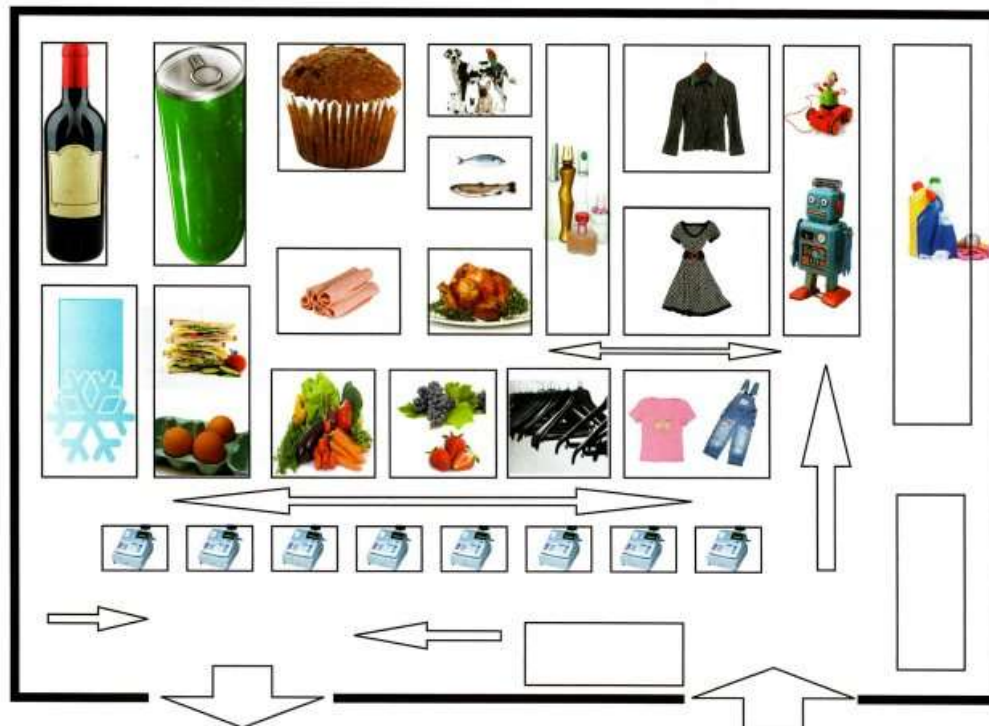


Scénario : shopping in Philadelphia

Thanks for re-organising the new flyer of the supermarket. Please write the following names of the departments at their appropriate place.

The Front desk is now situated on the right when entering the supermarket. The After-sales service is opposite the front desk, on the left, in front of the cash tills. There will be 8 Cashiers. The Household items are behind the front desk, on the right of the Toys department. The Men clothing department, women clothing department and children clothing department are between the toys department and the Perfume counter. We added some Fitting rooms next to the children clothing department, on the right of the Fruit counter. The Vegetables counter is between the fruit counter and the Fresh food department. The Deep freeze department is at the back of the supermarket in front of the Off licence department. The latter is on the left of the Beverages department. Then, the Cereals, coffee, tea and cookies department is now behind the Delicatessen department. We also switched the Fish department and the Meat department which are now in front of the Pet shop.

Don't forget to write down the Entrance and Exit.
